



# Bridges Hall JCR

## GUEST POLICY



By order of the Junior Common Room Committee, as approved by a General Meeting, on 17 March 2009. The following policy on Guests of the Junior Common Room shall be adopted effective 18 March 2009.

### General Provisions:

1. A Member of the Junior Common Room (JCR) may, when permitted, admit guests to the JCR.
  - a) JCR in this case means events and facilities run by the Junior Common Room Committee (JCRC) as well as the JCR.
2. Each Member will be permitted to admit one (1) guest at a time.
  - a) A record of guests admitted shall be kept by the Treasurer and Secretary.
3. Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guest(s).
  - a) In the event that disciplinary action needs to be taken as a result of the conduct of a member's guest they shall be levied against the member admitting the guest.
  - b) The JCRC may instruct the Senior Resident Tutor (SRT) on the most appropriate course of disciplinary action to be taken; the SRT may impose disciplinary action in addition to the disciplinary action of the JCRC.
  - c) Disciplinary action includes the imposing of charges and fines.
4. The JCRC or a General Meeting may rule on whether a guest has been properly admitted to an event or a facility.
5. At all times the JCR members have precedence over guests.

### Specific Provisions:

1. Guests shall not be admitted to Film Nights, as guests cannot be charged without violating copyright law.
2. Guests shall pay a fee of not less than £1 for the privilege of participating in Bar Quizzes. The charge shall be set, levied and collected by the Treasurer, in consultation and with the approval of the JCRC.
3. Members shall be able to purchase a Guest ticket for a named Guest, for specific specified events. Guest tickets for events shall be limited in number and shall cost more than members' tickets.

This policy shall be enforced to its fullest extent.
